Did you know....

The Housing and Historic Preservation Committee has been working to bring changes to current laws that would result in stricter fines and punishments for neglectful property owners.

The Beautification Committee and volunteers cleaned a dozen streets in Allentown, removing trash from every part of the neighborhood. They also installed and maintained the concrete planters, streetlight hanging baskets, and the neighborhood Christmas tree, all with donated plants and labor.

The Safety & Awareness Committee attended or held regular meetings with the Chief and officers of the Buffalo Police Department B-District station. As a result of these meetings, patrols were significantly increased. Regular meetings continue with the new B-District chief.

The Event Committees of the Allen West Art Festival, Allentown Fall Festival, Secrets of Allentown and monthly First Friday Gallery Walks brought over 65,000 visitors, vendors, artists, and local businesses to Allentown through events that encourage economic development and celebrate and enjoy the unique character of Allentown.
