Displacement of residents who cannot afford large property tax increases would be bad for neighborhood stability and diversity. The Allentown Association has been meeting with Assemblyman Sean Ryan and other partners to explore possible solutions, including an exemption from sudden, large property tax increases for low and moderate income homeowners.
